### **A RESOLUTION ADOPTING ACT 2011-676 OF THE EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEMS OF ALABAMA**

**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City of Adamsville City Council that Adamsville elects to come under the provisions of Act 2011-676 of the Regular Session of the 2011 Legislature.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that by electing to come under the provisions of Act 2011-676 the City of Adamsville agrees to increase employee contribution rates as specified by said Act for members of the Employee's Retirement System of Alabama.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the provisions of Act 2011-676 shall become effective the first day of the month next following the month of adoption of said Resolution.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the election of come under the provisions of Act 2011-676 is irrevocable as of the effective date of this Resolution.

Section 1. Any and all resolutions in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 2. The parts of this Resolution are severable and should any part or parts be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such ruling shall not affect the remaining parts.

Section 3. This Resolution shall go into effect on the first pay period of 2012 upon the passage and publication as required by law.
